Village of Caronport, Province of Saskatchewan Bylaw #: 2018-02

A Bylaw of the Village of Caronport for Regulating All Terrain Vehicles

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Village of Caronport.
 - (b) "All Terrain Vehicle" means all terrain vehicle as defined in *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
 - (c) "Chief of Police" means the Chief of Police of the Village of Caronport.
 - (d) "Designated area" means an area approved by the owner of the land and the Village Council of the Village of Caronport for All Terrain Vehicle use.
 - (e) "Highway" means a highway as defined in *The Highway Traffic Act*, 1996.
 - (f) Public Land" means public land as defined in *The All Terrain Vehicles Acts*.
 - (g) "Village" means the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Caronport, or, where the context requires, the geographical area within the Village limits of the Village of Caronport.
- 2. Except as provided in sections (3) to (5) of this Bylaw, all provisions of 'The All Terrain Vehicles Act' shall apply in the village.
- 3. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on public lands within the Village.
- Persons shall be permitted to operate an all terrain vehicle on the extreme right of highways within the Village at a speed of no more than 15 kilometers per hour, and;
 - (a) shall use only a direct route between their residence and the village limits, or;
 - (b) shall use only a direct route between their residence and a designated area, and;
 - (c) shall not operate an all terrain vehicle past 10:00 p.m. in the evening or before 7:00 a.m. in the morning, and;
 - (d) shall wear a helmet.
- 5. All terrain vehicles shall be equipped with factory exhaust systems.
- 6. a) Where a person commits or is alleged to have committed an offence for which a penalty is set out in Schedule "A" of this Bylaw, a peace officer or any other person authorized by the Chief of Police shall issue a Notice of Violation to such person.



- Voluntary payment of a penalty specified in a Notice of Violation b) shall be made on or before the date indicated on the Notice of Violation. Voluntary payment shall be made in person to the Village of Caronport Office during normal business hours.
- If payment of the amount specified on the Notice of Violation is c) made on or before the date indicated on the Notice of Violation, the person alleged to have committed the offence shall not be liable to prosecution for the offence indicated.
- If payment of the amount specified on the Notice of Violation is not d) made on or before the date indicated on the Notice of Violation, a peace officer or other authorized person shall issue or cause to be issued a Summons.
- The Notice of Violation shall be in the form established by the Chief e) of Police and shall provide for the voluntary payment of a penalty in the amount set forth in Schedule "A" for the offence which the person is alleged to have committed. The Summons shall be served by a peace officer or other authorized person.
- Voluntary payment of a penalty specified in a Summons shall be f) made on or before the date indicated on the Summons. Voluntary payment shall be made in person at the Village of Caronport Office during normal business hours.
- If payment of the amount specified on the summons is made on or g) before the date indicated on the summons, the person alleged to have committed the offence shall not be liable to prosecution for the offence indicated.
- If payment of the amount specified on the Summons is not made on h) or before the date indicated on the Summons, the person to whom the Summons has been issued shall be liable to prosecution of the alleged contravention of the Bylaw.
- Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any person i) from exercising his or her right to defend a charge of contravention of any provision of this Bylaw.
