First, we would like to acknowledge a significant transition within the Rec Board itself. Since our last update, there has been almost a complete shift in board membership. Loree Buck has stepped away from the board after years of faithful service, and we are sincerely thankful for the leadership, care, and dedication she brought to Caronport recreation.

We are happy to report that the board is now fully seated in accordance with our bylaws. Amber Quiring is serving as Chair and Secretary, Marcelo Ike as Vice Chair, and Angela Mundell as Treasurer, alongside three Members at Large: Joy Foreman, Tracy McLean, and Jim Bell. In addition, we are thankful for our dedicated program coordinators who work alongside parent volunteers to make these programs possible. Recreation truly takes a team, and we are grateful for everyone who contributes their time and energy.

Our three core clubs - hockey, skating, and soccer - continue to grow and serve a large number of children in our community. It is encouraging to see strong participation and enthusiasm year after year. Looking ahead, the Rec Board hopes to explore opportunities to expand programming beyond our core clubs, with the long-term goal of offering additional options not only for children, but for adults as well.

We encourage families to support local recreation by registering their children in Caronport-based programs, taking advantage of funding support programs such as KidSport and Jumpstart, and we welcome anyone with a passion for recreation or new programming ideas to contact us. Caronport Fire and Rescue is proud to serve the communities within RMs 162 Caron, 132 Hillsborough and 163 Wheatland, including the villages of Caronport and Mortlach. 2025 held a lot of change and growth for this department.



2025 saw a slight increase in calls from the previous year with 117 calls for service compared to 96 in 2024. This could be a result of a unfavorable winter driving season causing more accidents along the highway. The largest volume of calls was for medical assistance (39) and motor vehicle collisions (27). The department also responded to two structure fires, and eight grass fires this year.

The fire department went through several changes this year. Most notably was the construction of a second fire hall in the Village of Mortlach. The satellite hall enables faster response times from our members in Wheatlands to emergencies in the area. The hall currently houses a fire suppression truck with 1500 gallons of water, and a command truck with grass fire fighting capabilities. The department was able to procure over 30 thousand dollars in donations and grants to help with the purchase of a side by side and trailer in the new year. This unit will be used for both grass fire suppression and technical rescue in remote areas inaccessible by larger vehicles.



Members of Caronport Fire and Rescue work hard to train to a high level of service and meet professional standards of modern fire fighting tactics and practices. Over the 2025 season, members trained in vehicle extrication, water supply, portable fire extinguishers, fire control, and many other topics.

We are a department of over approximately 40 Paid on-call members and 12 Medical First Responders. Our 2026 will continue to build on the success of this year with quality training and member recruitment and retention efforts. From all of us at Caronport Fire and Rescue, we would like to wish you a safe and happy holiday season to you and your family! Merry Christmas!
